

POSTERS Y FOTOMURALES DE CHILE


MATERIALS NEEDED: Mounting Tape • 1 Cutter or sharp blade. • 1 plastic spatula (medium size and covered by a cloth) or a damp sponge



The wall mural includes: 3 panels (panel 1, panel 2 and panel 3, size 110 cms x 230 cms each). The panels are numbered on the backside (see figure A)

Before installing, only apply in clean, dry, smooth and flat surfaces. Do not apply on textured surfaces.

1 Position the panel 1 to the wall with mounting tape (see figure B). Check the panel 1 is in vertical position (also can start the installation on the right side of the wall, setting the panel 3 first)




2 Once the panel 1 is in the correct position, peel off the backing paper a few inches only across the top and do not peel off the entire backing paper of the adhesive (see figure C) and trim the edge on top (20 centimeters) with a cutter or sharp blade (see figure D).



3 Peel off the rest of the backing paper gradually and evenly (20 centimeters length) at a time, and with a plastic spatula (covered with a cloth) or a damp sponge rubbing softly from the center out (see figure F), to expel any air bubbles (do not scrub).

In order not to damage the panel, use light pressure. If wrong, remove the adhesive (panel) and start again.

Once installed the panel 1, repeat the process to apply with panel 2 and panel 3. Make sure each panel is aligned and check this by sticking the panel against the edge of the other panel and matching pattern on the mural (see figure G)



4 Revise la instalación final y corte el exceso de adhesivo en los bordes con un cúter o cuchillo afilado.
